This month we are reading *The Diary of Anne Frank* as part of our unit on the Holocaust. We are focusing on reading with proper inflection and using punctuation as a cue for pausing and characterization. Students are learning a great deal of history as well as literature. When we finish reading the diary, we will begin working on a short research paper over a Holocaust topic. Students will learn how to construct a formal paper following MLA format.

Every Friday students will continue to take either a vocab or spelling test. These alternate each week. You may refer to my lesson plans online for more details. Study guides are available in Google Classroom.
