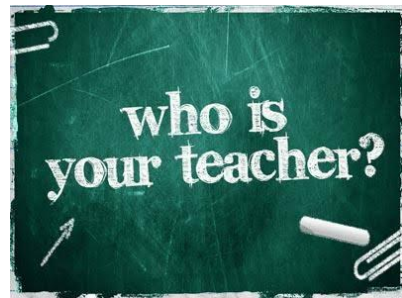
Don't forget to send a water bottle every day. We need to stay hydrated during this crazy hot weather!
