## **End of Instruction Notes - Day 8**

1970s—several Middle Eastern countries fight Israel and US with terrorism

1979—Soviets invade Afghanistan. Muslims head there to join struggle against Soviets.

Osama Bin Laden a 22 yr old from one of Saudi Arabia's wealthiest families founded al-Qaeda (rebel resistance). His experience in Afghanistan, now controlled by Muslim Taliban allowed him to try to drive Westerners especially Americans out of the Middle East. Osama Bin Laden and al-Qaida attacked American embassies, attempted bombing in Seattle, attacked American warship USS Cole, then the World Trade Center. President Bush said enough. Oct. 7, 2001 US began bombing Afghanistan—Taliban collapses. Jan. 2004, Afghanistan has new constitution. Jan. 2002—we go after weapons of mass destruction. Bush calls Iraq, Iran and North Korea the axis of evil. Saddam Hussein and Iraq are seen as the biggest threat. March 2003 US led coalition attack Iraq. Iraqi army dissolved. Saddam captured by end of year. The Kruds-Shiites-Sunnis are all fight for control of Iraq.

## **Important Amendments & Court Cases**

1857—Dred Scott v. Sanford—slaves not citizens, they were property

1865—13<sup>th</sup> Amendment—ended slavery

1868—14<sup>th</sup> Amendment—made all persons born in US citizens

1870—15<sup>th</sup> Amendment—protected voting rights of former slaves

1896—Plessy v. Ferguson—"separate but equal"

1913—16<sup>th</sup> Amendment—created income tax

1913—17<sup>th</sup> Amendment—direct election of senators

1919—18<sup>th</sup> Amendment—Prohibition

1920—19<sup>th</sup> Amendment—Women's suffrage

1933—20<sup>th</sup> Amendment—Lame Duck—moved Pres. Inauguration to Jan. 20

1933—21<sup>st</sup> Amendment—Repealed prohibition

1951—22<sup>nd</sup> Amendment—Presidential limitation to 2 elected terms

1954—Brown v. Board of Education—end segregation

1961—23<sup>rd</sup> Amendment—gave Washington DC electors to electoral college

1963—Gideon v. Wainwright—subjects are entitled to court appointed attorney if unable to afford one

1964—24<sup>th</sup> Amendment—abolished poll tax

1966—Miranda v. Arizona—police must inform suspects of their rights during arrest process

1967—25<sup>th</sup> Amendment—Presidential disability and succession

1971—26<sup>th</sup> Amendment—voting age lowered to 18

1992—27<sup>th</sup> Amendment—Congressional salary restraints
