

# **Sequoyah High School Concurrent Agreement**

## **PARENTAL CONSENT / ONE WAY TRAVEL CONCURRENT CONTRACT**

**OKLAHOMA STATE REGENTS DOES PROVIDE A TUITION WAIVER FOR CONCURRENT STUDENTS. STUDENTS /PARENTS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY ADDITIONAL FEES OR COST OF BOOKS FOR CONCURRENT CLASSES.**

**Native American students: It is your responsibility to meet any Scholarship offer requirements from your Tribe.**

**Concurrent Classes are NOT FREE. Students will pay for the Books and FEES, approximately \$77/Credit Hour.**

### **Example**

**One 3 hour class at the Reduced Price for Concurrent Class will be  $\$77.00 \times 3 \text{ hrs} = \$231.00$**

**I understand that no transportation is provided for any concurrent student.**

High school Seniors who meet the eligibility requirements qualify for tuition waivers for up to 18 credit hours of tuition. High school Juniors can receive tuition waivers up to 18 credit hours, subject to availability.

**STEP 1 . Please get a Parent Signature on this Concurrent agreement form and Submit to the **HIGH SCHOOL COUNSELOR BEFORE** your College admissions can be approved by the counselor.**

**STEP 2. Complete the college Admissions Application Online at the College that you plan to take Concurrent classes. EX: (RSU: [www.rsu.edu](http://www.rsu.edu))**

Concurrent classes are a choice and a privilege available to High School Juniors and Seniors, who meet the State and University requirements to participate. Students need to be mature enough for the work load of a college class. Students will need to take the ACT BEFORE enrolling at a College : with a minimum of ACT 19 Or the Pre-ACT score of Pre ACT of 19 AND Sub score of 19. This indicates Success in College Classes.. **Any concurrent student who fails to achieve the required 2.0 College GPA or below will not be eligible for Concurrent Enrollment. The grade of D in any Concurrent Class will Disqualify the student to continue Concurrent Enrollment.**

If you are taking an In Person Class, select the time of that class that will allow “ONE WAY” Travel. That means the student’s day at college will either begin at 8AM or 8:30AM or end with a class at 2pm or later. **Online classes will be configured into your schedule as allowed with High School classes**

**Every Concurrent grade earned will become part of the student's permanent High School Transcript, the College Grade may impact the GPA of the High School Student.**

I understand that the Oklahoma Department of Education guidelines are to substitute **ONE** High School class for **ONE** college class **ONLY**, and only **ONE** class will be substituted for **ONE** hour of Travel. Concurrent courses will replace the first hours of the day or the last hours of the day, even if it's an Online Class.

**CONCURRENT CLASSES ARE** required to be a **FULL 16 WEEK SEMESTER CLASS ONLY NO FAST TRACK CLASSES.** General Education Classes that are 3 hour class credit or more are Concurrent Classes. Just remember that these are College Classes with the rigor of College Courses.

I understand that the College course Final **Grade will be posted on my High School Transcript.**

**\*College classes will CLOSE** when the maximum number of students have been enrolled, **don't put this off. Start by turning in THIS Signed Parent Contract to the High School Counselor, then go to the College Website and Apply for Admissions, meet with your college academic advisor, select your college classes, and turn in your College Schedule to your High School Counselor.**

**If you are taking an OnLine class, you will need to be monitored for all Tests at the RSU Testing LAB.**

**IF you DROP your Concurrent Class By the College DROP deadline IMMEDIATELY Inform the High School Counselor, or that Grade will be posted as a FAILING Grade of F on your High School Transcript. This may also impact your Diploma Requirements, scholarships, etc . This will Disqualify you from continuing to take Concurrent courses - Please BE RESPONSIBLE.**

**What classes can you take as a Concurrent student at the college level? You may take General Ed classes, classes that will count as dual credit for both high school and college credit. All concurrent classes that are taken must be General Education classes at the college level. They must be a full semester in length, NO Fast Track Classes and 3 or more credit hour classes.**

**\*WEIGHTED CLASSES : Only in the following core areas of Math, English, Science, History will classes be weighted: See descriptions below for what classes will be weighted and that can be taken concurrently. WEIGHTED Concurrent CORE Classes**

**4.5 GPA      A= 4.5      B= 3.5      C =2.5      D = 1.5      F= 0**

**\*SENIORS ONLY can enroll in \*COMP 1 AND \* COMP 2 \* This is a Dual Credit class for SENIOR English ONLY if taken during Fall Semester 1 COMP 1 and Spring Semester COMP 2 of the SENIOR YEAR, it will replace the Senior English 0.5 per semester High School Credit and College Credit. \* WEIGHTED CLASSES 4.5\***

\* **US HISTORY** TAKE **BOTH** Before **AND** After 1877 **TWO SEMESTERS** 0.5 High School Credit per semester and College credit (DUAL Diploma Class) **\*WEIGHTED 4.5**

\* **GOVERNMENT** Replaces HS Diploma Required GOV 0.5 High School Credit and College credit (DUAL Diploma Class) **\* WEIGHTED 4.5**

\* **MATH** : College Algebra, Pre Calculus, or Trig ( DUAL Diploma Class) Math courses cover the entire text in a semester 1 Full High School credit per semester and college credit **\* WEIGHTED 4.5**

\* **SCIENCE: Biology , Physical, Chemistry, Environmental Science** This class requires a LAB and is a 4 hour class (DUAL Diploma Class) 1 full High School Credit and College credit. **\*WEIGHTED 4.5**

**All Other Concurrent Classes are 4.0 GPA and earn 0.5 Semester Credit per semester .**

**COMPUTER:** AFTER you have passed Fundamentals of Technology in High School

**GLOBAL STUDIES:** Human Geography, World Civilization, Civics, Values and Ethics

**FOREIGN LANGUAGE:** (After you have taken at least one year of Spanish at the HS)

CHEROKEE 1, GERMAN 1, SPANISH 1

**SOCIAL SCIENCE:** Psychology or Sociology

**FINE ARTS** : Humanities, Art, Cinema, Music Appreciation, Speech (2 classes replace one Full Credit of ART)

**\*SENIORS ONLY can enroll in \*COMP 1 AND \* COMP 2 \***

Concurrent College Classes are NOT FREE, at RSU they are approx. 77.00 per credit hour

**\*\* IF the student is taking an ONLINE Concurrent Class, they are required to Schedule and Take their College TESTS in the Testing LAB On the RSU Campus ONLY under the supervision of RSU .**

Just a reminder, Students will have a ONE WAY Travel. Students taking IN Person classes, must select an 8:30 AM class or a 2:00PM or later to accommodate dropping 1 class for 1 and 1 for Drive Time.

**By signing this Concurrent Agreement, I and my child(student) understand and agree to all of the requirements and information listed above. And Parents understand that they are responsible to pay for the Fees and Books for each Concurrent Class.**
