This is the Sequoyah High School Agreement / Parent Contract for the Concurrent enrollment program. Please remember that CONCURRENT CLASSES ARE NOT FREE!! RSU does provide a tuition waiver but Parents are financially responsible for the FEES/ and BOOKS for each class! TUITION FEE WAIVER GUIDELINES: High school SENIORS who meet the eligibility requirements qualify for tuition waivers for up to 18 credit hours and high school JUNIORS can receive tuition waivers up to 18 credit hours, subject to availability.

STEP 1. Turn in to the High School Counselor this form. PARENT SIGNATURE is required on this Parental Permission Form **SUBMIT to HIGH SCHOOL COUNSELOR BEFORE your College admissions can be approved by the counselor.

STEP 2. Complete the college ADMISSIONS Application Online at the College that you plan to take Concurrent classes. EX: (RSU: www.rsu.edu)

Concurrent classes are a choice and a privilege available to high school Juniors and Seniors, who meet the State and University requirements to participate. Students will need to take the ACT BEFORE enrolling at a College: with a minimum of ACT 19 Or the Pre-ACT score of Pre ACT of 19 AND Sub score of 19. This indicates Success in COLLEGE Classes.. Any concurrent student who fails to achieve the required at 2.0 college GPA or above shall not be eligible for concurrent enrollment. The grade of D will Disqualify the student to continue Concurrent Enrollment.

IF you are taking an IN PERSON Class, select the time of the class that will allow "ONE WAY" TRAVEL. That means the student's day at RSU will either BEGIN at college 8AM or 8:30AM or END take a class at 2pm or later at College. * The following are Weighted 4.5 GPA

*English (Comp 1 and Comp 2) .5 Credit per semester, BOTH Comp 1 and 2 = Eng 4

*Math (College Algebra ,Pre Calc or Trig) 1 Full High School Credit 1 credit per semester

*Science (Physical, Biology, Chemistry, or Environmental) 1 credit per semester

*History (Up to 1877, After 1877) .5 credit per semester and Government .5 Credit per

Since Math and Science cover an entire Book in a Semester and the Science has a Lab, therefore, those classes are 1 full credit per semester as a Weighted GPA.

Every Concurrent grade earned is part of the student's permanent High School Transcript, the College Grade may impact the GPA of the HS Student.

Concurrent Scheduling * **ONE** High School class will be substituted for ONE college class and only ONE class is substituted for travel = 2 classes in high school for ONE concurrent class ONLY. Concurrent courses will replace the first hours of the day or the last hours of the day .Only ONE class will be substituted for Travel Time.

CONCURRENT CLASSES ARE required to be a **FULL 16 WEEK SEMESTER CLASS ONLY No Fast** Track Classes. General Education Classes that are 3 hour class credit or more are Concurrent Classes.

I understand that the College class **GRADE** will be posted on the High School Transcript. I understand that the Oklahoma Department of Education guidelines are to substitute ONE High School class for ONE college class ONLY, and only ONE class will be substituted for ONE hour of Travel. I understand that no transportation is provided and the college class is **NOT FREE**, Parents are FINANCIALLY responsible for the FEES and BOOKS for the College Classes.

IN PERSON Classes at RSU:BEGIN YOUR DAY AT 8AM OR 8:30AM OR END YOUR DAY AT RSU 2:00PM OR Later

*College classes will CLOSE when the maximum number of students have been enrolled, don't put this off. Start by turning in your Signed Parent Contract to the High School Counselor, then go to the College Website and Apply for Admissions, meet with your college academic advisor.

IF you Fail to DROP your Concurrent Class By the College DROP Deadline IMMEDIATELY Inform the High School Counselor, OR that Grade will be posted as a FAILING Grade of F. This may also impact your Diploma Requirements, scholarships, etc. This will Disqualify you to continue Concurrent BE RESPONSIBLE.

What classes can you take as a Concurrent student at the college level. You may take General Ed classes, classes that will count as dual credit for both high school and college credit. All concurrent classes that are taken must be CORE or General Education classes at the college level. They must be a full semester in length, NO Fast Track Classes and 3 or more credit hour classes.

*WEIGHTED CLASSES: Only in the following core areas of Math, English, Science, History will classes be weighted: See descriptions below for what classes will be weighted and that can be taken concurrently. WEIGHTED Concurrent CORE Classes

- * **US HISTORY** TAKE **BOTH** Before **AND** After 1877 TWO SEMESTERS .5 High School Credit per semester and College credit (DUAL Diploma Class) ***WEIGHTED 4.5**
- * **GOVERNMENT** Replaces HS Diploma Required GOV .5 High School Credit and College credit (DUAL Diploma Class) * **WEIGHTED 4.5**
- * MATH: College Algebra, Pre Calculus, or Trig (DUAL Diploma Class) Math courses cover the entire text in a semester 1 Full High School credit per semester and college credit * WEIGHTED 4.5
- * SCIENCE: Biology, Physical, Chemistry, Environmental Science This class requires a LAB and is a 4 hour class (DUAL Diploma Class) 1 full High School Credit and College credit. *WEIGHTED 4.5

All Other Concurrent Classes are 4.0 GPA and earn .5 Semester Credit per semester .

COMPUTER: AFTER you have passed Fundamentals of Technology in High School)

GLOBAL STUDIES: Human Geography, World Civilization, Civics, Values and Ethics

FOREIGN LANGUAGE: (After you have taken at least one year of Spanish at the HS) CHEROKEE GERMAN 1, SPANISH 1

SOCIAL SCIENCE: Psychology or Sociology
