

Hmmm... The dash is used to set off parenthetical material that deserves emphasis, to set off appositives that contain commas, or to prepare the reader for a list, a restatement, an amplification or a dramatic shift in tone or thought. This phrase about the ways that cities' inhabitants navigate through tumult and crisis is none of these. Rather, it's a sentence fragment, and, more specifically, a subordinate clause. It has a subject and a verb, but because of the 'about' it needs to be affixed to something else to make sense.
