ACADEMICS THIS WEEK

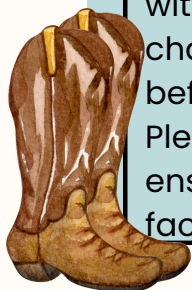
Reading—Story Elements
